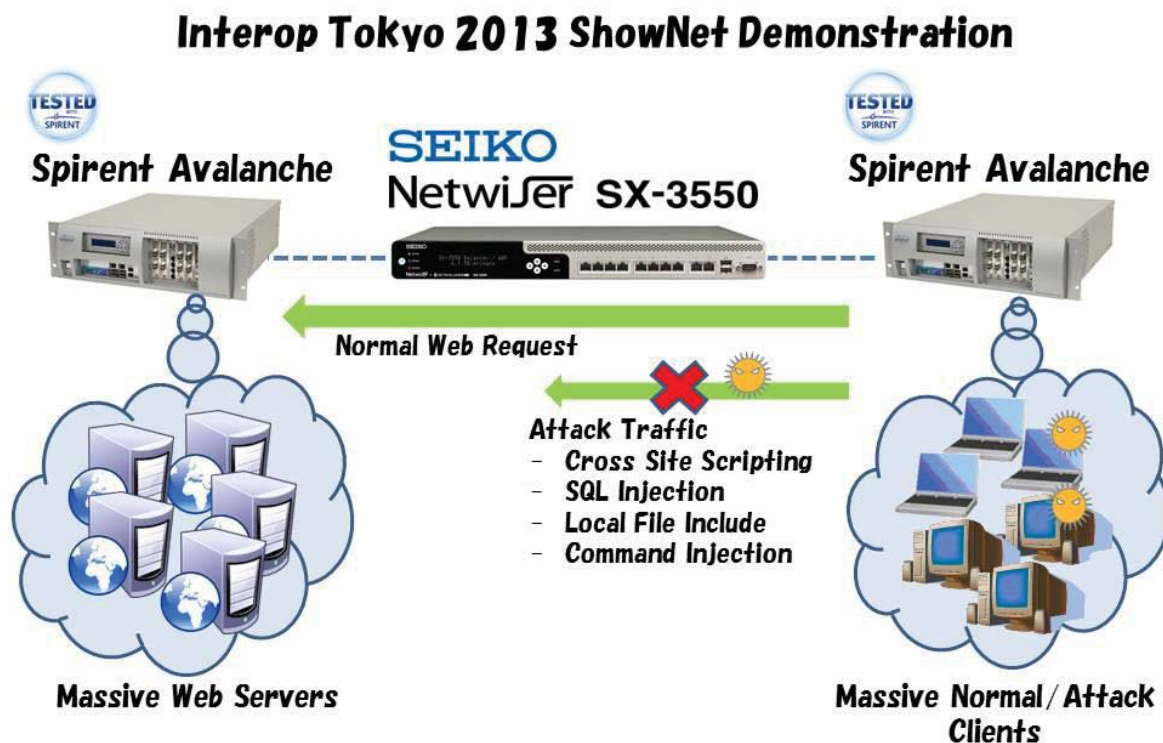


TOYO provided demonstration jointly with Seiko Solutions at INTEROP TOKYO
- Netwiser SX-3550 blocked web application attack traffic transmitted by Avalanche -

TOYO Corporation (HQ: Chuo-ku Tokyo, President and CEO: Masaru Gomi) provided a joint demonstration with Seiko Solutions (HQ: Chiba-shi Chiba, President: Takaaki Yamamoto) at INTEROP TOKYO 2013, one of the largest network computing exhibitions in Japan. Both Seiko Solutions and TOYO exhibited their latest solutions and presented a joint demonstration using these solutions at their respective booths.

[Demonstration details]

- The Avalanche, the application performance tester of Spirent Communications in the US, exclusively represented by TOYO in Japan, transmitted to Seiko Solutions' application firewall, "Netwiser SX-3550" a mixture of normal traffic and attack traffic including cross site scripting, SQL injection and other cyber-attack traffic against web applications.
- "Netwiser SX-3550" identified cyber-attack traffic to a web application server based on the patterns of the traffic transmitted on the network and blocked only the attack traffic while allowing all normal traffic to pass through it (please see the illustration below for more details).
